

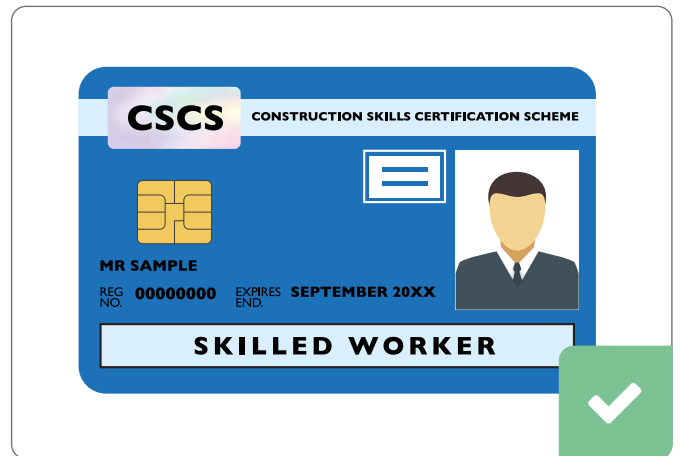
Before we can send you out on site we require proof of identification as well as verification of your valid CSCS card. The quickest and easiest option of sending this to us, is by taking a photograph.

We do however have some guidelines to how we expect to receive these photos, so that we can ensure the quality of the photo is approved by compliance. When submitting photos please can you ensure that you follow the guidelines below.



Passport photos:

- ✓ Make sure you copy the photo page only.
- ✓ Has no reflections or flash glare
- ✓ All details/text must be clear



CSCS Card photos:

- ✓ All four corners are shown.
- ✓ Has no reflections or flash glare
- ✓ Displays a valid date.



Ensure that the photograph is not blurred or distorted. Also avoid using photo filters.



To avoid rejection ensure that your thumb or fingers do not feature in the photo.



Ensure that when submitting your photos that all four corners are visible in the shot.



Avoid taking photos from an angle. Take photos directly from above capturing all 4 corners evenly.



Try to avoid glare and flash reflections in your photos. The photos need to be easily recognisable & all details visible.



Ensure that your name, photo and expiry dates are all visible to avoid having the photo rejected.
